First Grade Phonics and Spelling List 12 has words in the “ch” family. The pretest will be on Wednesday and the final test on Friday.

Kindergarten Language Arts Students will be writing the letters w and x as well as saying the sounds they make in words.

First Grade Language We continue to work on rules for capitalization and punctuation.

Social Studies Students will learn that history tells the story of people and events from the past.

Sight Words Continue working on the sight word list that was sent home with your child on Friday. If your child is struggling with the words, it is better to spend 5 minutes each night rather than 30 minutes on one night.

Daily Homework In preparation for a heavier work load in the upper grades now is the time to establish the concept of having homework. Train your child to think of reading as their homework each night. If you miss a night be sure to remind your child that they must do a little more reading on the next night to make up for the night that they didn't do their homework.
